

Australian Commercial Aviation Collection 2008

1.0 AIM

To define the guidelines for accepting donations into the private Australian Commercial Aviation collection owned and operated by Rob Tonge.

2.0 POLICY

Donations are welcome and are gratefully accepted as long as the following criteria are met.

2.1 The objects are relevant to and consistent with the purposes and activities of the collection as stated in the collections mission statement and collections policy.

2.1 The collection must be able to provide for the storage, protection, and preservation of the objects under conditions that ensure their availability for the collections purpose.

2.2 The objects are in reasonably good physical condition or can be conserved within the collection's resources.

2.3 All donations are considered outright and unconditional gifts to be used at the discretion of Rob Tonge.

2.4 The materials or objects must, be the legally owned and unencumbered.

2.5 All objects entering the collection must be in a condition that they will not cause injury or damage to other objects in the collection, storage or display facilities, or individuals working at or visiting the collection.

2.6 Any object must be less than three meters squared to be eligible for inclusion into the collection. This is due to space and financial considerations, unless storage for a larger object is possible.

2.7 The receipt of any donation will be taken as evidence that this policy has been read and fully understood and agreed to unconditionally.
Please note that this collection is a private collection and as such an absolute guarantee that any donated object will be preserved for ever can not be given.
